

Market Swine

- 1) Market swine weighing less than 185 and more than 280 will be sifted
- 2) Barrows & unbred gilts only may be shown as market swine.
- 3) Ear notching is allowed if done by the State Validation deadline.
- 4) 5 animals can make a breed
- 5) All animals not classified by the classifiers as a Berkshire, Duroc, Hampshire, Yorkshire shall be placed in the Cross/Other Class
- 6) OPB shall consist of the Berkshire, Duroc, Poland and Spotted breeds.

BREEDER SWINE

Gilts under one (1) year will be shown as breeding animals. All registered gilts must be registered in the name of the exhibitor/family prior to December 1, of the year preceding the show. Gilts that are not registered and did not show in the market show may be shown in the breeding show as an unregistered gilt. ~~Gilts that are sifted for being under 185 and over 280 can show as a breeding gilt.~~
